Index Strategy

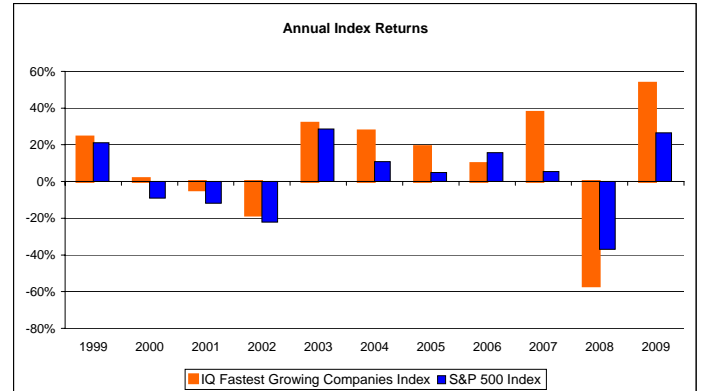
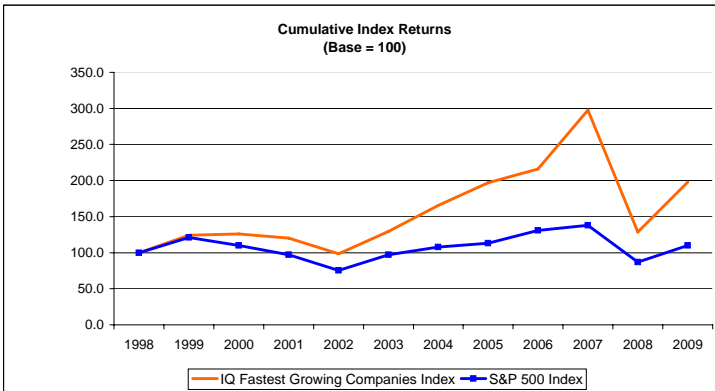

R-Squared is a measure of how closely performance can be explained by the performance of the benchmark index (in this case, how closely performance correlates with the S&P 500).

Beta reflects the sensitivity of a portfolio's return to fluctuations in the market (in this case, as measured by the S&P 500 Index).
