Fund description

The IQ Hedge Macro Tracker ETF seeks to track, before fees and expenses, the performance of the IQ Hedge Macro Index.

The Index attempts to replicate the risk-adjusted return characteristics of a combination of hedge funds pursuing a macro strategy and hedge funds pursuing an emerging markets strategy.

The Fund does not invest in hedge funds and the Index does not include hedge funds as components. The Fund is not suitable for all investors.

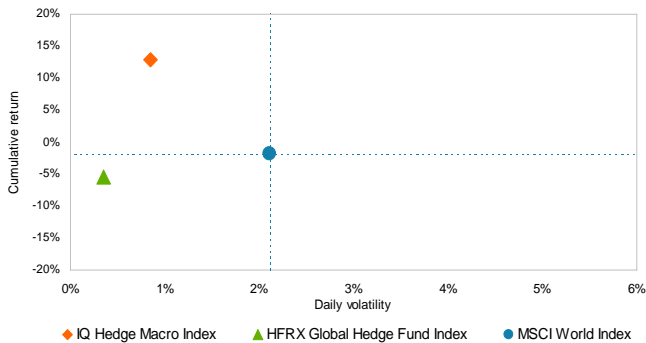

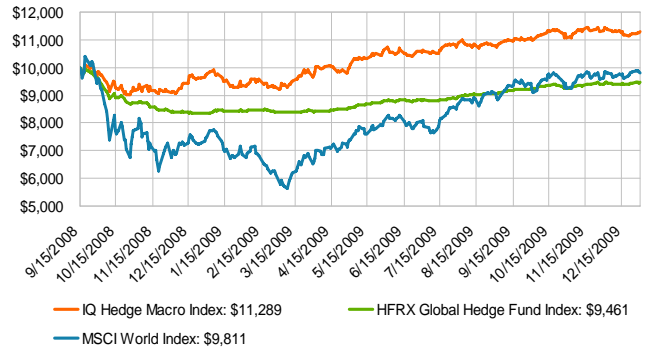

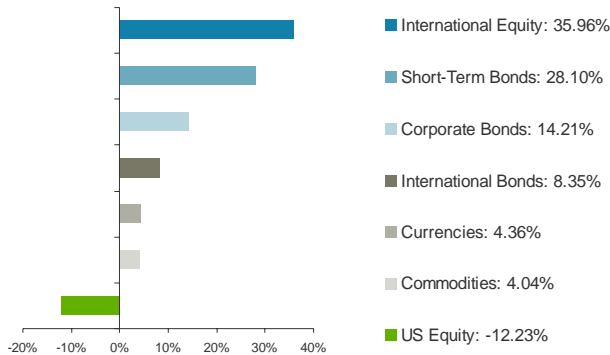

The maximum drawdown analysis measures the largest decline between any two points in the monthly return history of the respective indexes, and indicates the time period during which such drawdown occurred, as well as the date on which the index's returns had fully recovered (if applicable) all losses incurred during the drawdown period.

Risk Discussion: The Fund's investment performance, because it is a fund of funds, depends on the investment performance of the underlying ETFs in which it invests. There is no guarantee that the Fund itself, or any of the ETFs in the Fund's portfolio, will perform exactly as its underlying index. The Fund is non-diversified and is susceptible to greater losses if a single portfolio investment declines than would a diversified mutual fund. The Fund's underlying ETFs invest in: foreign securities, which subject them to risk of loss not typically associated with domestic markets, such as currency fluctuations and political uncertainty; commodities markets, which subject them to greater volatility than investments in traditional securities, such as stocks and bonds; and fixed income securities, which subject them to credit risk – the possibility that the issuer of a security will be unable to make interest payments and/or repay the principal on its debt – and interest rate risk – changes in the value of a fixed-income security resulting from changes in interest rates. Leverage, including borrowing, will cause some of the Fund's underlying ETFs to be more volatile than if the underlying ETFs had not been leveraged. Investing in foreign markets subjects the Fund to risks not typically associated with domestic markets. Loss may result because of less foreign government regulation, less public information and less economic, political and social stability. Loss may also result from the imposition of exchange controls, confiscations and other government restrictions. Foreign risks will normally be greater when the Fund invests in emerging markets. The ETF is new and has limited operating history.

The MSCI World Index is a free float-adjusted market capitalization weighted index that is designed to measure the equity market performance of developed markets (performance data assumes reinvestment of dividends, but it does not reflect management fees, transaction costs or other expenses). The HFRX Global Hedge Fund Index is designed to be representative of the overall composition of the hedge fund universe. It is comprised of all eligible hedge fund strategies; including but not limited to convertible arbitrage, distressed securities, equity hedge, equity market neutral, event driven, macro, merger arbitrage, and relative value arbitrage. ¹The Fund employs a "passive management" – or indexing – investment approach designed to track the performance of the Index. The Fund invests primarily in the Index components that comprise the Index.

²As stated in the Fund's prospectus, the expense ratio of 0.75% is expressed as a unitary fee to cover expenses incurred in connection with managing the portfolio. In addition to this expense ratio, the Fund will indirectly bear its proportionate share of the fees and expenses of the underlying ETFs in which it invests. As of August 26, 2009 the Fund estimated that these fees, known as "Acquired Fund Fees and Expenses," would be 0.35% annualized for the fiscal year ending April 30, 2010. However, this amount will vary over time due to changes in the underlying ETF fees and expenses and the constitution of the Index.

Fund shares are not individually redeemable and will be issued and redeemed at their NAV only through certain authorized broker-dealers in large, specified blocks of shares called "creation units" and otherwise can be bought and sold only through exchange trading.
